She is the Support to Ministries Representative/Lay for the Northern Plains Conference. A SAM person is a lay person authorized by the Synod to conduct many of the responsibilities of an ordained pastor. Ray can preside at a communion service, funeral and many other official duties. Our Church Council has asked Ray to fulfill these duties in the absence of a full time pastor.

April 30, at worship we will finally be able to hold Harvestfest that was postponed last fall and waiting for better weather this spring. Joining us will be Pastor Jeff Backer. He is the pastor at St Dysmas ministries of the South Dakota State Penitentiary. He will share what God is doing in the prison through this mission. Call Committee Update

Many of you are wondering where we are at in the calling process. At this time our site-study is being shared by the synod with potential pastors. Until we get the okay to share a name with our congregation the process is confidential. We continue to ask for everyone's prayers as we move forward.

As you can understand this past winter has been difficult for everyone's personal and professional lives. So we ask for patience and know God is in charge.

Message from Ray

Grace and Peace from God our Father, and from our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, who is the Son.

Take a few minutes and turn off all the noise in your home. No radio, no television, no computer, no music, just silence. Find a chair and sit with your feet flat on the floor, let your arms fall to a comfortable position and close your eyes. For 90 seconds notice your breath. Just your regular breath going in and out. It will seem like a very long time. Keep your eyes closed and think about the muscles in your jaw. Tell them to relax. Think about the muscles in your neck, tell them to relax. Let your shoulders fall and think about the muscles in your back, relax. Chest and stomach, relax. Lower back, relax. Legs relax. Finally tell your feet to relax. Remain relaxed and notice your breathing again. Relax. Say to yourself, "God, thank you for this day." Take a deep breath and open your eyes.

In March we walked with Jesus toward Jerusalem. It was Lent. It was a time to think about our sins, realize we are imperfect beings, to be contrite and express penitence. On Palm Sunday we celebrate Jesus the Messiah as King of the Jews. The King who fulfils the Old Testament, enters the synagogue and claims his place as THE ONE.

Maundy Thursday and Good Friday services are considered two halves of the same service. On Thursday hands are laid on each of us and the words, "In obedience to the command of our Lord Jesus Christ, I forgive you all your sins. Amen". You have received the Word of Our Lord. On Friday we remember the Passion of Christ. Sunday morning, Easter, we celebrate again. Jesus has risen, he has risen indeed.

Christ died for our sins and takes his place as King on the throne in Heaven. SIN IS DEAD!

Think of each sin you can remember from the last year. Think about each one individually and the feelings you had. With each thought say to yourself, "I am forgiven." And let it go. It is in the past. God gave us two eyes in the front of our heads to see forward. It takes effort to stop, turn your head and your body, and look back at where you have been. If God wants you to see the past he would have given you eyes in the back of your head. The past is gone. SIN IS DEAD. Move forward and serve the Lord. Thanks be to God. Amen

The Church Council met on March 19. CC minutes from February 5 were approved.
